How Fundraising Helps

Each time we rehabilitate an orphaned cub, it costs in the region of £3,000 per animal from point of care to release back into the wild. We rely completely on donations and profits from our online shop, so if you feel you're able to help us continue this valuable work with an iconic species, we would really appreciate your support.





We also have three permanent residents at our rescue centre that cannot be released into the wild – Reggie, Maxwell and Tolga.

Choose Your Fundraiser Individual

- Set up your Facebook birthday fundraiser to raise money for UK Wild Otter Trust. Create a simple fundraise through Facebook and let your family and friends protect otters in honour of you.
- Set a personal challenge and ask you friends and family to sponsor you online. Ideas –
 give up your favourite food for 3 months? Do 100 sit-ups every day for a month? Walk
 your dog for 3 miles a day?
- Do a sponsored head shave, leg wax or beard shave.
- Have a clear out and declutter. One person's trash is another person's treasure. You could sell the items online through platforms such as eBay or Facebook Marketplace or at a car boot sale and donate the funds to UKWOT.
- Collection bucket/tin.
- Is there a word or phrase you use too much? Every time you say it, put £1 into a jar and donate the collection to UKWOT.
- Support us on your special day by asking for a birthday, engagement, anniversary or easter donation instead of gifts, cards or chocolate eggs?
- Hold a charity bake sale.
- Sponsored litter pick. Which also helps otters and other wildlife.

Group/Family

- Hold a virtual or in person quiz. Charge your friends a fee which is then donated to UKWOT. Check out our quiz template on our website.
- Have a virtual dinner party with friends over video call and donate the money you would have spent on a night eating out.
- Golf tournament.
- Bingo. Make sure to read our fundraising guidelines section.
- Event gala or masquerade ball
- Charity sporting match.
- Sponsored litter pick. Which also helps otters and other wildlife.



Choose Your Fundraiser Children

- Sponsored reading challenge. For every minute of reading the kids do donate an amount of your choice to UKWOT. You could even turn it into a tournament.
- Get into the garden and start a household ball keepy-uppy competition. Start a collection jar and donate 10p per keepy-uppy, whoever does the most wins half of the jar, with the other half donate to UKWOT.
- Sell old toys or get crafty and sell the items.
- Sponsored events swimming or football matches. Battle of the bands.
- Bake sale.
- Art competition.
- Easter egg hunt.
- Sponsored silence.
- Sponsored litter pick. Which also helps otters and other wildlife.



- Dress up or down
